Dear parents,

Ensuing to G.O No. 19-Edu of 2021 dated 22.01.2021 of the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the reopening of the schools in the Union Territory of J&K with the following conditions and instructions:

In continuation with our efforts to start physical classes in school itself, we are very happy to announce the opening of the classes for our other grades as per the given schedule. However, the online classes from **Nursery to Grade VIII** will commence from **Wednesday, 3rd March, 2021**. The classes will start from **10:00 am** onwards, for which the schedule will be uploaded on our school website. Then the physical classes will start from **8th march** as per the schedule given below.

Grades: V to VIII

Physical classes shall commence from **Monday 8th March, 2021**. The students will attend school in two groups.

Group I - Roll no 1 to 15.

Group II -Roll no 16 onwards.

Group I will attend physical classes on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays**

Group II will attend physical classes on **Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays**.

Grades: I to IV

Physical classes for these grades shall commence from **Monday 15th March, 2021**. The students will attend school in two groups.

Group I - Roll no 1 to 15.

Group II -Roll no 16 onwards.

Group I will attend physical classes on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays**

Group II will attend physical classes on **Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays**.

Nursery and KG

The **physical classes** for these classes shall commence from **Monday 22nd March, 2021**. The students will attend school in two groups. The timing for the classes will be different and will be communicated later.

Group I - Roll no 1 to 15.

Group II -Roll no 16 onwards.

Group I will attend physical classes on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays**

Group II will attend physical classes on **Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays**.

Students of all the above mentioned classes shall only be permitted to attend physical lessons after the submission of **NO OBJECTION/CONSENT LETTER** by the parents of the student in the format attached here with. The consent forms must be submitted in the school by or before 4th, March 2021.

Furthermore, the submission of the **'Fitness Certificate'** along with the NO OBJECTION/CONSENT LETTER is mandatory, and must be duly signed by a registered medical practitioner. The certificate should clearly mention that the child is not having any COVID-19 related symptoms and is healthy.

No student shall be permitted to attend physical lessons without the written consent of the parents and the Fitness Certificate.

- All students attending physical lessons must be in full winter school uniform.
- The maximum strength per section will be 15 students.
- Children will not be assembled for morning assemblies or any other physical activity.
- Children will only get to have their dry snacks during a short break of 15 minutes.

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- There shall be no use of the playground too.

Arrival & Dispersal

Parents are requested to **pick and drop** their wards on their own till further government orders regarding school transport. Parents will be intimated accordingly. As limited number of students shall attend per day, they must line up before the commencement of lessons, with supervised social distancing and for compulsory thermal scanning. If there is any indication of raised temperature, the student shall be immediately segregated and the parents shall be informed to take their ward home immediately. The student shall not be permitted to return for physical classes until a negative test report for COVID -19 is submitted by the designated authority.

- Students must use sanitizer upon entering the gate. important

In the best interest of health safety it is compulsory for students to:

- Wear face masks at all the times.
- Carry a small sanitizer bottle for personal use.
- Water bottle
- Snack box (preferably dry lunch, to be finished within 15 minutes)
- Gloves for added protection.
- No child suffering from cold, cough and fever is to be sent to school.
- In case any family member is COVID-19 positive, the child should not be sent to school.

Time table

- The class time table shall comprise of five periods per day.
- Children are expected to carry written material only, which should not be shared in the interest of health safety.
- No mobile phones will be allowed within the campus.

For reassurance of parents, the following needs are to be kept in mind

- All classrooms used by students shall be sanitized before the students enter.
- To avoid physical contact between considerable numbers of children, there shall be no assembly, or permission to use the playfields.
- Sanitizers shall be available in the public areas in addition to the personal sanitizers compulsorily carried by each student.
- Hand washes shall be available in the lavatories.
- Furniture in classrooms has been arranged to ensure a minimum of Six feet distance in the seating of each student.
- All students shall be sensitized about the spread of COVID-19 and the measures to prevent it. It is being brought to your kind notice again that present steps are taken to gradually resume all physical classes.
- All reasonable precautions, as given above, shall be enforced.

Lastly, we all know that health is the prime priority in these testing times and all of us are working towards keeping our kids safe and healthy. In order to minimize the health hazards, we would appreciate the parental cooperation in making our efforts possible by counselling the children regarding the COVID-19 SOP's to be followed within the school premises as well as outside.
